

WORKPLACE LEARNING with RoxMAPP

Workplace Learning with RoxMAPP is designed to provide a seamless, supported pathway to the world of work and career over the course of the students' six years in the program. The Workplace Learning (WPL) sequence of coursework, job shadows, worksite visits, internships, and mentorships is intertwined with requirements for a high school degree at Madison Park Vocational High School (MPTVHS) and an AS/AA degrees at Roxbury Community College (RCC). As students gain skills in both their academic and technical coursework, they will be asked to apply that skill to a real need in a real work setting.

As students move through the sequence, they steadily shift the balance of their time and focus from school to work, just as they simultaneously shift their balance from high school core requirements to college degree completion. Students will move from spending 100 percent of their workplace learning time at school to spending 100 percent of it in the real workplace, fully engaged by the needs of the employer.
