ELEMENTARY SCHOOL - Our youngest artists come to RAW full of energy and lots of questions about who they are, where they come from, and how to belong. Eager to share their dreams about their future, nervous about the street life they experience all too frequently, and often distrustful of people who look or act different from them, they soon discover that RAW is a place that lets them slow down, breathe, make friends, and be a kid.

MIDDLE SCHOOL - At this crucial moment when kids are looking for new mentors and role models, RAW is there for them. They want to be cool but are not quite ready or are all-too-quick to define what cool is. RAW is a safe, accepting space that also sets boundaries on how to be cool without being hurtful. At an age when art can disappear out of a kid's life, RAW also reminds them that their individual creative expression is valuable. Kids who are challenged to reflect on the choices they are making and how important it is to be true to who they are on the inside, and not just conforming to stereotyped identities.

HIGH SCHOOL - Even through high school years, teens still long to belong. The magic at RAW is the huge diversity of groups and the meaningful celebration of that diversity. Our oldest participants, many of them first and second generation immigrants, are encouraged to own and share their unique culture and story of self through their artworks. There is an emphasis on holding kids to high expectations, on setting goals and helping them work towards them. Overall, our programming for high school aged teens prepares them for the world they are about to enter and gives them a myriad of communication, artistic, and leadership skills to help them thrive beyond the walls of RAW.

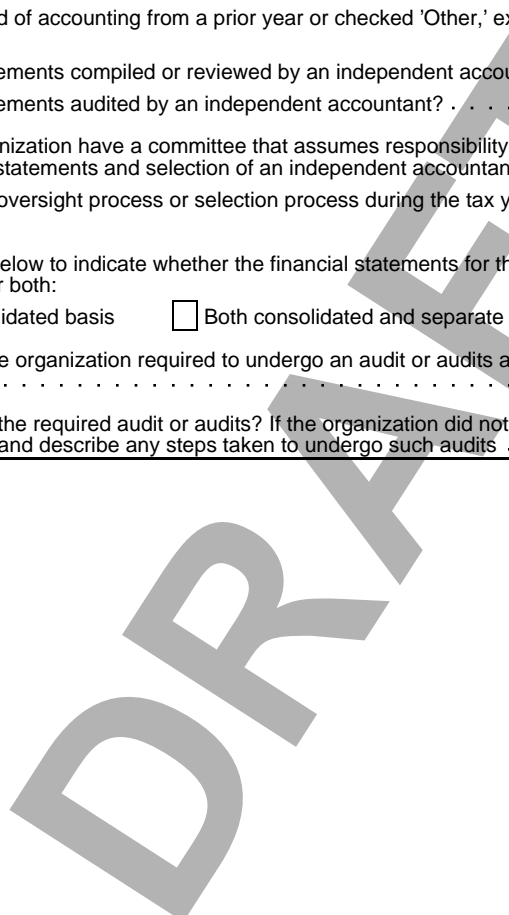
