In June 2012, NSIV took over the previously subleased 3700 sq ft biotech laboratory and purchased all the equipment within. By June 2013, the end of the fiscal year, we had graduated three companies, but had grown to eleven in our Biotech Incubation Program. Five startups were utilizing the labs; six other startups were developing a variety of medical-related technologies. Approximately 56 people were employed by these eleven startups. Expenses grew significantly due to the costs associated with operating the laboratory but program revenues kept pace to cover operating costs. A grant from the US EDA and corporate sponsorships provided funds to staff the program. Pro bono support from corporate sponsors and volunteer mentors was critical to the success of this program, and totaled more than our cash revenues.

The Cleantech Incubation Program graduated another four companies during the year bringing our total to seven companies employing 51 people at fiscal year-end. Most of the startups in the Cleantech Program either only use office space or are virtual members utilizing services but no dedicated space. We continue to keep an 1100 sq ft lab available for each cleantech startup which resulted in high operating expenses compared to revenues. At year end, we had six companies in the program employing 20 people.
