Grateful Soup!

Every Monday, Wednesday and Friday two or three people gather in the kitchen of Emmanuel Church to prepare lunch for our community. A large soup pot is taken out, water and ingredients added.

Each day the soup is different. The ingredients are rescued from local stores and donated by people who bring in beans and leftover vegetables. The soup is simple, and the people working in the kitchen are both unhoused and housed. Together they make enough food to feed the 100 people gathered in the fellowship hall. They talk about their lives – what brought them there that day or where they slept the night before. People gather in a safe warm place to be seen, to create art, and to warm up with a bowl of soup.

This is how we do our work and ministry. We gather – housed and unhoused persons alike - to build intentional spiritual community on and off the streets of Boston. We are able to do this work because of the resources you provide.

We could not do this work without the foundations, churches and individuals like you that support our beloved community. It is because you show up, you donate, you give your time and treasure. Your support allows us to...

..Worship outdoors every Sunday for more than 22 years. In 2017 42 housed communities joined us on the Common to provide a simple lunch and be in fellowship.

...Hold CityReach 7 times a year. In 2017 we welcomed 48 housed communities (more than 600 people) as well as providing clothing and food to over 1200 unhoused Bostonians.

...Grow the BostonWarm day center, bringing in new community members and volunteers each and every week.

...Support our unhoused members as they recover from injury or illness at the respite care facilities of Boston Healthcare for the Homeless - Barbara McInnis and Stacy Kirkpatrick Houses.

...Welcome people into our bible studies and special events.

We are all grateful for your help and your care for our community.

"I come to *common cathedral* because it is a community where I can see the Gospel at work, changing lives, practicing love, and painting a picture of the resurrection as a lived experience. The people of *common cathedral* help me remember: In the very public outdoor worship open Sundays on the Common I see traces of the Apostles' work in the Book of Acts — simply speaking the love of God in Christ to an often bewildered and sometimes intrigued city. In the gatherings during the week — *common art*, the BostonWarm day center, Feed Your Spirit bible study, CityReach — I see people practicing love towards each other in a dedicated, gritty, practical, and genuine way. And it's not all smiles and hugs. It's patiently listening to someone who is freaking out. It's laying out a giant blue tarp and rolling out tables and making chili in order to build a space where people feel safe, warm, and comfortable. It's celebrating new housing and birthdays, or mourning dead companions, or dancing to silly music played poorly (or masterfully!) on a clunky old church piano that doesn't even belong to us. It's taking out the trash and stowing away the art supplies. It's making sure there's an Uber to take someone home who has trouble walking. It's the constant aspiration to do all of these and more things even better".

Meet John

John Lane grew up in Wallingford, CT. He earned his B.A. in English Literature from Boston University. For many years, John worked for a firm specializing in fundraising for non-profits, rising to the position of VP of telemarketing and fundraising, as well as serving as HR director for the operations division. Following a change of ownership, the principals on the executive team were let go, and John found himself unemployed.

"Quite a few years of heavy drinking, depression, many small and part-time positions and almost the whole of my finances later, I found myself living in a small room in a house in South Boston. Finally, even holding down the job providing that small rent became impossible, and I became homeless in the spring of 2010."

At first John stayed at Boston's Night Center, then in one of two shelters on Long Island. Together with hundreds of others, John's life was torn apart in October 2014 when the Long Island Bridge was condemned. For months after the bridge closure, he stayed in a crowded basketball gym, waiting for the Southampton shelter to be completed.

A full year later, housing came through for John. But John was still depressed, and for more than a year rarely left his apartment.

John writes: "One Thursday in July 2017 I was at the BostonWarm day center and staff member Sharon said to me, 'John we're short a volunteer and you don't seem to be doing anything. Get behind the table and serve lunch.'"

"The common cathedral community has become central to my life."

John is now one of our most dependable supporters - at the BostonWarm day center, at *common art*, on the CityReach staff, and at Sunday Outdoor worship as well.

"I, who had grown up lapsed Catholic, was not just for the first time in 30+ years taking Communion - I was part of the Church, part of the service that was celebrating the Sacrament. It was terrifying and very out of character, and for reasons I still can't fully state, it felt wonderfully appropriate."

"The *common cathedral* community has become central to my life...It is an extension of my family; a place I go to feel love, to serve my community, to be forgiven...to try to comprehend God. Far more than my apartment ever will be, *common cathedral* is my home."

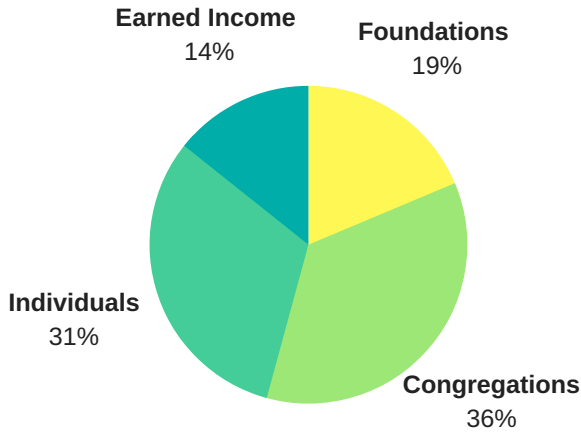

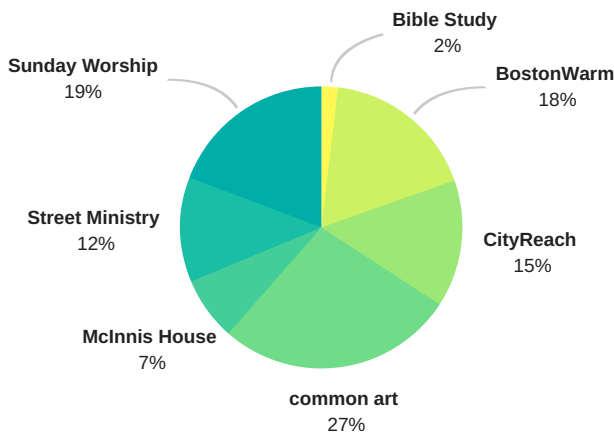

The difference in revenue over expenses is the result of designated funding that was received in 2015 for work that was completed in 2016 and 2017.





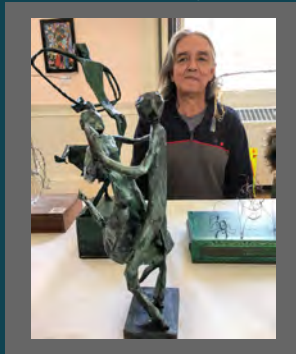
